The conference will cover all aspects of nuclear-related research conducted in academia and industry. Group leaders will present the overall research theme/objectives of a research centre, followed by group members who will present on their specific research areas. The following themes will be covered:

- Modelling
- Materials & Applications
- Radiation Science and Reactor Technology
- Waste Minimisation
- Radiation Protection and Safety
- Uranium-based Research
- Other (systems, thermodynamics, etc.)

### **Exhibition Benefits**

SANHARP continuously explores new ways and partnerships to create a base for industry key players to discuss issues affecting the Nuclear Sector in South Africa as well as the required skills for the sector.

The Exhibition provides your organization with an opportunity to showcase career and vacation work opportunities, postgraduate learnership/internship programmes, brand identity and specific employment brand or educational opportunities available.

The exhibition also enables your organisation to directly interact with key industry players, universities, research institutions and role models in various science, engineering and technology (SET) careers, and will include a showcase of student projects within a science and engineering careers theme. SANHARP will charge a nominal fee of R5 500.00 to R7 500.00 for the cost of supplying the exhibition infrastructure, catering and logistics for **both days**. Light meals and refreshments for exhibitors will also be provided on each day. The exhibition stand will comprise a 3m (deep) x 3m (wide) maximum height of 2,5m shell scheme system, two spotlights, plug point, carpeting and stand furniture. Should you have additional needs, these can be catered for through our exhibition partner at an additional cost determined per individual requirement. Your company will also be responsible for costs such as accommodation, transport and any other additional meal costs.

The Exhibition will be held at the iThemba LABS Exhibition Hall (directions to the venue will be communicated to you on confirmation of your participation). If you would like to confirm your participation at this event as an exhibitor, please note that we require your participation for **both days (13 & 14 October 2011)**. Setup is expected to commence on Wednesday 12 October 2011.
