FIRST CIRCULAR

iThemba LABS is hosting the 2nd International African Symposium on Exotic Nuclei (IASEN-2024) which will be held from 9-13 December 2024.

This Symposium is jointly organized by <u>iThemba LABS</u>, South Africa and <u>Joint Institute for Nuclear Research</u> (JINR), Dubna, Russia).

The Symposium will be held at a Venue close to Cape Town, South Africa.

The Symposium will be devoted to the investigation of <u>nuclei in extreme states</u>, in particular, at the limits of nuclear stability (from very light neutron- and proton-rich to super heavy nuclei).

- Fundamental Research with Radio-active Ion Beams (RIBS)
- Applications with RIBS
- Nuclear Reactions & Astrophysics
- Nuclear Structure

A school will be held for students on the day before the Symposium, Saturday 7 December.
