The 6th in the series of the International Conference on Collective Motion in Nuclei under Extreme Conditions (COMEX6) will be held from Monday October 29, 2018 to Friday November 2, 2018 in Cape Town, South Africa.

Conference Venue

The conference will take place at the **Protea Hotel Fire & Ice**, 64 New Church Street, Tamboerskloof, Cape Town, South Africa. This vibrant hotel has the perfect location in the Cape Town City Bowl, being only 3.6 km from the V&A Waterfront and 4.2 km from the Table Mountain Aerial Cableway. Tamboerskloof is one of the oldest residential suburbs in Cape Town, and lies on the slopes of Lion's Head and Signal Hill, adjacent to the neighbourhoods of Gardens and Bo-Kaap. Gorgeous views of Table Bay, Lion's Head and Table Mountain make this a popular suburb and the perfect location from which to explore Cape Town. Kloof Street, known as the city's 'restaurant mile', is a quick walk from the hotel.
