This is the third and final circular for the African Nuclear Physics Conference (ANPC), which will be held from Monday July 1, 2019 to Friday July 5, 2019 at the Protea Hotel Kruger Gate at Kruger National Park in South Africa.

We have received significantly more abstracts than can be accommodated which made the review process very challenging and difficult choices had to be made. Due to the limitations on the number of delegates that can be accommodated at the venue we are unable to host a poster session.

Registration

Please register at <https://anpc2019.tlabs.ac.za/registration/> by no later than 20 May 2019. The registration fee for participants is ZAR 6 000 and for students a discounted fee of ZAR 2 000 will apply. The fee for accompanying persons is ZAR 2 500.

Conference Registration Desk

The Conference Registration desk will be available from Monday to Friday during conference hours. Registration will also be open on Sunday evening 30 June during the Welcome Cocktail from 18:00-20:00.

Conference venue and hotel accommodation

The conference will take place at the Protea Hotel Kruger Gate, South Africa, near the Kruger Gate at Kruger National Park. Accommodation at the conference hotel is limited and attendees are encouraged to book directly with the Protea Hotel Kruger Gate as soon as

possible. Alternative accommodation options are available in surrounding lodges or in Hazyview which is 45 minutes away by car.
